

Mission: We are a spiritually dynamic body of believers who are being transformed and empowered by the Word and the Spirit to experience the victorious Christian life, to change the world in which we live for Christ, and to multiply the kingdom of God.

Mission Vision: We are growing as believers in our personal lives. We are learning to love God and love others. We are reaching Latin America and the world with the Good News of Jesus Christ. People are growing in their love for God and their neighbor. Worshipping God takes priority over daily concerns. Reaching the world for Christ is motivated by a true love for God, a concern for neighbors, and a passionate commitment to the Spirit and the Word of God.

Mission Goal: Effectively discipling spiritually passionate servant-leaders who are being used of God to transform the world for Christ.

Mission Priorities: We emphasize the following priorities in our ministry:

Provide ministry mentorship, biblical training, and worship skills to national leaders.

Encourage and assist local churches in evangelistic outreach.

Protect and disciple impoverished children.

Statement (Confession) of Faith: We are an independent, Bible-believing, evangelical mission society.

1. The Bible is the inspired Word of God, the written record of His supernatural revelation of Himself to man, absolute in authority, complete in its revelation, final in its content, and without any errors in its teachings.

2. All men in their natural state are lost, alienated from God, spiritually dead: "All have sinned, and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

3. Salvation is only by grace, a free gift of God, through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, who died for our sins according to the Scriptures (1 Cor. 15:3). Those who thus receive Christ by faith have their sins forgiven (Eph. 1:7), their hearts cleansed (Acts 15:9), are born of the Spirit, become children of God (Jn. 1:12, 13), and are made new creatures in Christ (2 Cor. 5:17).

4. God is one God, Who reveals Himself in three Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Jesus Christ, as the Scriptures affirm, is the Son of God and the Son of man. He was born of a virgin and is Himself very God. The Scriptures also declare the deity and personality of the Holy Spirit.

5. Our Lord Jesus Christ rose from the dead in the same body that was laid to rest in the tomb (Jn. 20:25-27). Those who have trusted Christ shall spend eternity with Him in heaven. Those who have not will spend eternity in a literal hell.

6. Christians, born of the Spirit, are to live the new life in the present power of the Spirit. "If we live by the Spirit, by the Spirit let us also walk" (Gal. 5:16-25; Col. 2:6). The Christian's responsibility and his normal attitude of life is to yield himself to God (Rom. 6:13), trusting God to keep him.

7. Christian "living" includes service, the winning of souls around us, the preaching of the Gospel in the uttermost part of the earth, and the daily yielding of self to the Spirit. In carrying on this work there is needed the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit which is granted to every believer as he yields and trusts (Acts 1:8, 1 Cor. 12:7, Eph. 3:20, Acts 5:32). And in this service, prayer is to have the central place (Jn. 14:12-14, Eph. 6:18, 19).

8. The church is to be led and taught by pastors whose main function is to shepherd and teach the flock. Deacons assist the pastors in the daily duties of the church. Any baptized (immersed) believer who supports the position of the church shall be a part of the church. The Lord's Supper is an important component of our spiritual growth since it reminds us of the crucifixion and return of our Lord. The entire membership of the church is responsible to care for the church, live the Christian life, and support the work of the pastors and the church at large. We believe that a Christian relinquishes all rights to direct the use of the tithe or offering once the gift has been made to the church or mission. We believe in the autonomy of the local church free of any external authority or control. (Acts 13:1-4; 15:19-31; 1 Pt. 5:1-4; Gal. 6:6; 2 Cor. 9:6-7)

9. We believe that the Bible clearly teaches that homosexuality, abortion, and euthanasia are sins against God and humanity.

10. We believe that God has called men and women of every tongue and tribe to be members of the kingdom of God. We invite people of any ethnicity who embrace our statement of faith, bylaws, and teachings, and, who otherwise qualify for participation to join our ranks as we seek to do the will of God.
